

"Mr. Wolf" plays the music of Wes Montgomery with contemporary arrangements and modern grooves. The playing-fun of these 3 musicians is infectious and you won't be able to sit still. Except all the famous Wes song the band play own compositions in 'Wes-style' as well. Lovers of WES, bluesy guitar, soulful hammond and funky drums, have been wildly enthusiastic so far!

Wes Montgomery is considered by many to be the greatest jazz guitarist of all time. His unique style: the melody and solos in octaves, rhythmic motifs with block chords and fiery improvisations – often bluesy and soulful – are a great example to many musicians.

The band members of MR.WOLF have performed with Candy Dulfer, Jhelisa Anderson, Benjamin Herman, Berget Lewis, Ruth Jacott, Bill Evans, ... and many others.

Interesting fact: guitarist Wim Overgaauw, former teacher of Wolf Martini performed with Wes Montgomery on national TV in 1965 in Holland.

"Wes Montgomery's music is like a tattoo on my eardrum – that's how many times I've heard this guitar legend's music. At some point I wished to hear his music with a beat that includes everything that came after Wes' untimely death. His recordings from the 60s had Latin influences that invite to add grooves. I couldn't find anything like it anywhere – well, so I arranged it myself with drummer/producer Robert Biesewig and Hammond virtuoso Simon Oslender and recorded it."
